A Level AAB level (at least two science subjects to include Chemistry and a third academic subject) or equivalent eg HKDSE at 5, 5, 5 in three elective subjects (which must include Chemistry). Integrated or combined sciences are not accepted. Plus at least 5,5,4,4 in the four core subjects incl. English Language at Grade 5. Plus English language entry requirements: HKDSE English Language Grade 5 or IELTS 7.0 with 7.0 in each component; or equivalent.

Medicine with Foundation (MBBS with Foundation)

A Level ABB level (at least two science subjects to include Chemistry and a third academic subject) or equivalent (136 UCAS points) Plus English language entry requirements: HKDSE English Language Grade 5 or IELTS 7.0 with 7.0 in each component; or equivalent.


