Change of exam session is not permitted unless on medical grounds and it can be changed once only. Candidates have to complete the [Change of Exam Session form](#) and submit a medical certificate within THREE working days after the exam. An administration fee will be charged for this service.

CONFIRMATION

- Receipt will be sent to candidates by email once payment has been settled
- A confirmation e-mail will be sent to candidates approximately 1 week before the exam date

EXAMINATION DAY

- Candidates are required to arrive at the exam venue 15 minutes before the start of the exam
- Latecomers will not be admitted into the exam room
- Candidates need to bring printed confirmation e-mail, identity document (with photo, name in English, date of birth), such as student handbook, pencils, rubbers and coloured pencils comprising black, blue, brown, green, grey, orange, pink, purple, red and yellow
- Candidates are allowed to bring transparent bottled water into the exam room. Water will also be provided on request

RESULTS

- Certificates will be sent to the address on the registration form by local courier registered mail about 6 to 8 weeks after the exam
